### WHERE OUR MOCCASINS LEAD US

The ministries of the Native American LINK are many. Most see us as women who sing in the Native Praise Choir, since it is the most visible; yet, these women are the feet and hands of our ministry. Our team of women lead in carrying monthly ministries throughout Oklahoma and beyond. They are our eyes and ears that God uses to help us recognize needs where we can serve. Here is a brief description of what 2023 has looked like:

January Supplies to pregnancy center in McAlester, OK

<u>February</u> Offerings to Bacone College, Muskogee to aid in keeping doors open for Native students

<u>March</u>-"Gotcha" bags to share with the homeless (snacks, underwear, socks, wet wipes, etc.) in our communities

<u>April</u> Clothing for center for women & children/victims of domestic violence

<u>May</u> Devotional books to Mabel Bassett Women's Correctional Facility <u>June</u> Backpack campaign for school supplies. Partnered with FoNAC (Fellowship of Native American Christians) & Native Stone Church VBS <u>July</u> Supply door prizes for the 25th Anniversary of LINK at Indian Falls Creek Bible Study and Skills Sessions

<u>August</u> Distributed gift cards to Native classroom teachers to show support and appreciation

<u>September</u> Offerings for Missionary Alpha Goombi (Nebraska) to provide assistance during hospitalization/rehabilitation.

<u>October</u> Offering for KWEK Society for Period Poverty to assist with feminine supplies for Native female students

<u>November & December</u> Donations of diapers, clothing given to the Seminole Nation Foster Care Program . Also, providing funds for seminary student

On November 14, 2023, during the Oklahoma **Baptists Annual Meet**ing, Willene Pierce, founding Executive Director/Treasurer of The **Native American LINK**, Inc. was honored and inducted into the Oklahoma Baptists Hall of Fame. Dr. Emerson Falls, Native American Specialist submitted a nomination for Willene to be considered, and she was selected. The family of Willene Pierce who attended were Stacy and Karen Pierce Smith, and LaVeta Pierce Sergeant. The current Native American LINK Executive Board were also able to attend. Willene served as Executive Director-Treasurer of The Native American LINK, Inc. during the years of 1998-2013. She continued to serve as Consultant to the ministry until her death in 2014.
